1 approximately \$10,658.00. The actual billings were \$9,932.00. My billings
2 for the months of May and June were \$1,224.00 and \$4,809.00,
3 respectively. That produces a total of \$23,404.00.

4 4. Work in process for July is \$1,890.00 through 10:00 a.m. on July 8, 2004. I
5 estimate the work to be needed to finish the Reply Brief, review
6 Commission Staff's Brief and review the Commission Order to entail
7 another \$1,050.00.

8 5. The decision of AWRI to forego the Initial Order removes the potential for
9 two further rounds of comments and briefs in this proceeding. That
10 produces the difference between the initial estimate contained in Exhibit 91
11 and the estimate contained in this Declaration.

12 6. The estimate for legal fees of \$26,344.00, plus the fees contained in Exhibit
13 96 of \$936.00 and Ms. Parker's revised estimate of \$14,666.91 produces a
14 total rate case expense of \$41,946.91.
