Pursuant to the all-party settlement stipulation in Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission Docket UE-090205, enclosed is the quarterly report on renewable energy credits (RECs) for the quarter ending March 31, 2011. Confidential Tables 1 and 2 are provided on vellow paper in the enclosed sealed envelope. An original plus one redacted copy of Confidential Table 1 and Table 2 is also enclosed, together with CDs containing both versions of each table in original format.

Confidential Table 1 provides information on RECs generated, retained, and sold from January 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011. The 2010 data has been updated since the previous report to incorporate low impact hydro certification for Oregon RPS eligibility. Confidential Table 2. provides the revenues associated with RECs sold during the first quarter of 2011 (January 1, 2011 through March 31, 2011).

Please note that the data provided in Confidential Tables 1 and 2 is confidential and provided subject to the terms of the protective order in Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission Docket UE-090205. As provided in the stipulation, a copy of the report is also being provided to Public Counsel and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities.
