Pursuant to Order 01 in Docket No. UT-110321, Telrite Corporation d/b/a Life Wireless is required to audit its Lifeline customers' eligibility through the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS).

Telrite hereby notifies the Commission that it submitted to DSHS April 3, 2018, in an electronic format required by DSHS, the records of its Washington Lifeline customers who qualify based on their participation in Medicaid, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, Supplemental Security Income and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families as of December 31, 2017.

Once Telrite receives the audit results back from DSHS, the company will take corrective action on subscribers identified as being ineligible.
