Dear Mr. Killip:

Pursuant to section 54.313(i) of the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC's") rules,<sup>1</sup> all eligible telecommunication carriers that receive high-cost and/or low-income support must file Form 481 by July 1 with the FCC to continue receiving such support. AT&T Mobility LLC ("AT&T") hereby provides a copy of its FCC Form 481, Carrier Annual Reporting Data Collection Form.

However, AT&T is unable to certify at this time that it filed with the FCC, as the following message is received when AT&T attempts to enter the report into the Universal Service Administrative Company ("USAC") website:

"Form 481 certification has been temporarily disabled to resolve a system issue. You can continue working on your filing, but will be unable to certify at this time. You will be notified when certification has been re-enabled."

To ensure the report is not filed late with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("WUTC"), AT&T Mobility LLC is submitting all other portions of the 481 certification filing and will file the certified copy as soon as the USAC website allows it to certify the data.

The collection of data and information contained in FCC Form 481 is done under the FCC's authority in section 254 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 254, and sections 54.313 and 54.422 of the FCC's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 54.313 and 54.422.
