3. WNIDCL is a democratic labor organization that represents more than 10,750

members in Washington and Northern Idaho. Petitioner is an affiliate of the Laborers

International Union of North America ("LiUNA"), which represents 500,000 members primarily

employed in the construction industry, and is the 8th largest labor organization in the United

States.

4. WNIDCL's members have a substantial interest in Hydro and Avista's proposed

merger filed on September 14, 2017. Hydro and Avista's proposed merger would substantially

and directly affect approximately 100 WNIDCL members who perform work for construction

contractors working on the Avista system, including NPL, Northstar Enterprises, Spokane

Traffic Control, Max J Kuney, Gargo, and Lydig. Petitioner's members work on numerous

Avista construction projects in Washington.

5. Petitioner and its signatory construction contractors are parties to collective

bargaining agreements with respect to the rates of pay, benefit packages, and employment

conditions for certain construction workers employed on Avista projects.

6. As the bargaining representative of members employed by certain Avista

construction contractors, WNIDCL's intervention serves the public interest as well as the

interests of its members. Petitioner and its members can provide relevant and necessary

information related to the proceeding, including wage rates, training requirements, construction

standards, local employment impacts, and workforce development investments. No other party

can represent the interests of WNIDCL.

7. As described above, WNIDCL has a direct and substantial interest in this

proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by
