On December 22, 2010, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice Permitting Oral Rebuttal and Surrebuttal Testimony Regarding Settlement Agreements; Requiring Issue Statements; Permitting Closing Arguments; and Rescheduling Post-Hearing Briefing Deadline (Notice). Given the numerous settlement agreements filed in the matter and the resulting narrowing of issues, the Commission determined that the post-hearing briefing could be accomplished on an abbreviated schedule. Thus, the Notice revised the post-hearing briefing deadline from February 7, 2011, to January 18, 2011.

On December 28, 2010, Cbeyond Communications LLC (Cbeyond), Level 3 Communications, LLC (Level 3), Sprint Nextel Corporation (Sprint), and the Joint CLECs¹ filed a Joint Motion to Revise the Briefing Schedule. Due to scheduling conflicts, movants request that the deadline for post-hearing briefs be set for January 31, 2011.
