- 1 Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. C-1052 stands in the name of Seattle Express, Inc., and authorizes passenger and express service as therein set forth.

- 2 On March 23, 2004, a joint application, D-79265, was filed for authority to transfer all rights under said Certificate No. C-1052 from Seattle Express, Inc., to Miller and Schmer, Inc., d/b/a Seattle Express.

- 3 It appears that Miller & Schmer, Inc., d/b/a Seattle Express, is able and willing to furnish all services necessary under Certificate No. C-1052, and that all rights transfer to Miller & Schmer, Inc., d/b/a Seattle Express, as requested will not be detrimental to the interests of the public.

ORDER

- 4 WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That the application be and the same is hereby granted, conditioned upon compliance by all parties concerned with the law and rules governing auto transportation companies, and subject to any legal claims, liens or equities.

- 5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. be reissued to Miller and Schmer, Inc., d/b/a Seattle Express, per attached Appendix A. All parties interested should take notice that the Commission in granting authority for the transfer of rights under a certificate does not necessarily approve the amount involved in the transaction, nor does it bind itself to recognize such amount in placing a value for rate-making purposes on the property of the certificate holder.
- 6 The Commission further orders that the tariff and time schedule filed in connection with this application will become effective at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the service date of this order.
