On October 14, 2004 I contacted Ms. Michelle Brooks, Secretary/Vice-President of Boots, Inc., concerning an economic technical, educational assist recheck as required by their six-month provisional status of their household goods permit operation.

Records were examined for the period of September 1, 2004 thru September 30, 2004 with the following results:

WAC 480.14.110 - Carrier's address and phone number are those listed with the Commission.

WAC 480.14.360 - Original permit posted on the wall of their residence/office so that the public can observe that they are properly licensed with the Commission.

WAC 480.14.480 - Annual report is not due until May 1, 2005, covering the period of June 21, 2004 thru December 31, 2004.

WAC 480.14.530 - Current liability and property damage insurance matches the information on file with the Commission, which is State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company, Policy # 0500845-D25-47C, in the amount of \$750,000 CSL.

WAC 480.14.550 - Cargo Insurance still has not been obtained although insurance broker is still shopping.

WAC 480.14.590-600 - Carrier does not lease equipment.

WAC 480.14.610 - Carrier is now advertising with HG-61386 number displayed in the ad and/or on their trucks.

WAC 480.14.720 -Carrier is now using the appropriate Househ Goods Bills of Lading.

WAC 480.14.740 - Bills of Lading do contain required information.

WAC 480.14.620 - Carrier does handout "Rights & Responsibilities Guide" to each customer,

but the drivers are not always obtaining the required signature on the bill of lading.

WAC 480.14.490 - Carrier does have a current copy of Tariff 15A and it is available to the public.

WAC 480.14.640 - Carrier is aware that verbal estimates are not allowed.

WAC 480.14.630-690 - Carrier does issue non-binding estimates and I found no apparent violations.

WAC 480.14.800-870 - Carrier is now maintaining a claims register and currently has had four claims and all four were handled appropriately.

WAC 480.14.190 - Carrier is operating within their permit authority.

WAC 480.14.300 - Carrier is in-compliance with the conditions attached to its' temporary provisional status.

WAC 480.14.390 - Carrier is operating under their permit name and/or trade name.

WAC 480.14.430-450 - Carrier has not been suspended and/or cancelled during period of operation.

WAC 480.14.900-930 - Carrier does not operate in interstate commerce.

WAC 480.14.360 - Carrier does keep copies of permit authority in all three trucks.

WAC 480.14.560 - Carrier's trucks are now properly identified with permit name and HG-61386 number on bothsides of power unit doors via a magnetic sign.

WAC 480.14.600 - Carrier does not lease equipment.

All violations were discussed with Ms. Michelle Brooks, Secretary/Vice-President, and several items were corrected before I left and she had a drivers meeting regarding entries to be signed and initialed on bills of lading.

As soon as I received confirmation of cargo insurance coverage from Ms. Michelle Brooks, I will be recommending issuance of their permanent authority.

I am submitting this assignment for closure.
