Discussion

On June 8, 2004, Speedy Delivery, LLC filed Application No. P-79301 requesting permanent household goods authority.

The Commission granted the company temporary authority subject to conditions pending a decision on its application for permanent authority. The company has operated under Household Goods Carrier Permit No. HG-61514 since October 4, 2004.

Application No. P-79301 appeared on the Commission's October 11, 2004, application docket subject to comment for no less than 180 days while the company conducted operations under its temporary authority. No comments were received.

Under the provisions of WAC 480-15-330 the Commission will grant or deny an application for permanent authority after conducting a complete review of the application filing, supporting statements, reports, or other information necessary to determine fitness, public interest, and current or future public convenience and necessity.

Matt Deter, 100% owner of Speedy Delivery, LLC has four years experience running furniture deliveries for a large furniture store and four years of experience owning a delivery business providing contract delivery services for

multiple furniture stores. The applicant has not been convicted of a Class A or B felony or previously been denied authority based on fitness.

Compliance staff worked with the company providing technical assistance during its temporary operations. Investigator Bruce Grimm completed a Safety Compliance Review and a Household Goods Technical Assistance and Records Review Checklist. Investigator Grimm found the company in general compliance and April 14, 2005, he recommended the applicant be considered for permanent authority.

Speedy Delivery, LLC is registered with the Secretary of State and holds a valid UBI number with tax registration, industrial insurance, and unemployment insurance accounts.

Speedy Delivery, LLC primarily provides retail store delivery services, with an occasional household goods move. During its provisional operations the company completed two household goods moves. The Commission received no customer complaints regarding this company's service.

Recommendation

P-79301 is an uncontested application and therefore no hearing is required. There are no outstanding issues that suggest staff should ask the Commission to set the application for hearing.

I recommend that Licensing Services Staff prepare an order to grant Application No. P-79301 without hearing and reissue Permit No. HG-61514 to Speedy Delivery, LLC as unrestricted permanent authority to operate as a household goods carrier in the state of Washington.
