- Household Goods Carrier Permit No. HG-173 stands in the name of Tri-City United, Inc., d/b/a Larsen Transfer Co., and authorizes the transportation of household goods in the state of Washington.
- On April 17, 2006, an application was filed under the provisions of RCW 81.80, and WAC 480-15 rules relating to household goods carriers for authority to enable Dean R. Jackson and Daniel W. Drefs, to acquire control of Tri-City United, Inc., d/b/a Larsen Transfer Co., through purchase of corporate stock.
- The application includes statements supporting a transfer of permanent authority under the exceptions of WAC 480-15-260. The applicant is fit, willing and able to acquire control of the requested permit and it appears that the permanent acquisition of control as requested will not be detrimental to the interests of the public.
- The commission having considered the application and being fully advised finds that the existing service is needed to satisfy the public convenience and necessity and it would be in the public interest to grant the application pursuant to the provisions of WAC 480-15-330.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That application P-79444 to enable Dean R. Jackson and Daniel W. Drefs, to acquire control of Household Goods Carrier Permit No. HG-173, standing in the name of Tri-City United, Inc., d/b/a Larsen Transfer Co, through purchase of corporate stock is granted.
