**Q. Please state your name and business address.**

A. My name is Eric E. Englert. My business address is 10885 N.E. Fourth Street, Suite 800, Bellevue WA 98004-5579.

**Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE") as Manager, Regulatory Initiatives & Tariffs.

**Q. What are your duties as Manager, Regulatory Initiatives & Tariffs?**

A. I am responsible for: the management and direction of the preparation of tariff and other regulatory filings; the research and development of regulatory policy and strategy on tariff and other regulatory initiatives; and the interpretation of tariffs and rate schedules.
