- 1 On August 10, 2007, CWA, Inc., d/b/a Travel Washington Grape Line, filed an application under the provisions of RCW 81.68.046 for temporary authority to operate as an auto transportation company.
- 2 The Commission, having considered the application and being fully advised in the matter, finds that the applicant is fit, willing and able to provide the necessary service; that in view of the existing circumstances, the issuance of an auto transportation company certificate is consistent with the public interest; and that it would be in the public interest to grant the application.

**ORDER**

- 3 IT IS ORDERED That the application is hereby granted, that upon complying with the laws and rules relating to auto transportation companies, a certificate be issued to CWA, Inc., d/b/a Travel Washington Grape Line authorizing the carrier to operate as a temporary auto transportation company providing service as described on the attached Appendix A.
- 4 The temporary authority granted by this order under the provisions of RCW 81.66.046 is subject to protest for 20 days from the date published by the commission on the application docket.
- 5 The Commission further orders that the tariff filed in connection with this application will become effective at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the service date of this order.

**PASSENGER SERVICE BETWEEN: Walla Walla and Pasco, WA**

This temporary certificate will expire automatically, by operation of law and without further Commission action 180 days following its effective date. The expiration date is April 10, 2008.

If the applicant files a parallel permanent application within 30 days of the grant of this temporary certificate then the temporary certificate will end when (1) the Commission enters an order approving withdrawal of the permanent application, or (2) the Commission enters an order granting the permanent application.

If the Commission denies, dismisses, or grants less than all of the permanent application this temporary certificate will terminate on the last day for seeking judicial review of the Commission decision or, in the event of judicial review, on any later date that the reviewing court may order.
