- On December 6, 2007, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Penalty Assessment TV-072234 against Daniel J. Busby, d/b/a Careful Movers (Careful Movers) in the amount of \$2,000.00, alleging a violation of RCW 81.80.070 by transporting household goods for compensation on the public highways of the state of Washington without the necessary permit required, and a violation of RCW 81.80.357, which requires a commission permit number be listed in any advertisement of household goods moving services.
- 2 On December 17, 2007, Careful Movers filed with the Commission a request for mitigation of the amount of the penalties.
- On December 19, 2007, Commission Staff filed a Response to Careful Movers Application for Mitigation.
- The Commission will hear this matter pursuant to Part IV of RCW 34.05 pertaining to adjudicative proceedings, including but not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.431, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW 34.05.452. Statutes involved, in addition to those previously cited, include those within RCW 81.01, RCW 81.04 and RCW 81.80, including but not limited to RCW 80.01.040, RCW 81.04.380, RCW 81.80.130, RCW 81.80.280, RCW 81.80.290, and RCW 81.80.330, and under WAC 480-07 and WAC 480-15, including but not limited to WAC 480-07-145, WAC 480-07-150, WAC 480-07-440, WAC 480-07-450, WAC 480-07-470, WAC 480-07-490, WAC 480-07-495, WAC 480-15-130, and WAC 480-15-450.

The ultimate issues include whether the penalty should be mitigated and what actions are necessary for Careful Movers to maintain substantial future compliance, pursuant to statutory provisions of RCW 81.04.
