The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) will review Avista Corporation's (Avista) integrated resource plan for natural gas service at a public meeting on April 15, 2010. Please also send us the text in your choice of .doc (Word 97 or later) format labeled with the docket number assigned to the integrated resource plan (UG-090015) and the commenter's name and type of software used. Comments may also be submitted via the Commission's Web portal at www.utc.wa.gov/e-filing or by electronic mail to the Commission's Records Center at records@utc.wa.gov.
