

- 1. Ensure that each driver qualification file is complete. At a minimum, it should contain a DOT type employment application, background investigation including an initial copy of the driving record, medical certification, and road test or CDL equivalent. Drivers who have been employed at least twelve months should have a current violation list, abstract of driving record and a documented annual review of driving record in file. See 49 CFR Part 391 for more information.
- 2. Ensure that drivers comply with the federal and state hours of service standard found in 49 CFR Part 395. Property carrying drivers are restricted to 11 hours driving and 14 hours on duty following 10 consecutive hours off duty. Instruct drivers in how to comply with these rules as well as the 34 hour reset and 60/70 hour on duty restriction. Monitor hours of service records to prevent violations. Appropriate hours of service standards are important to addressing a major facotr identified in many vehicle crashes--fatigue.
- 3. Ensure that maintenance files properly identify each vehicle with year, make, serial number and tire size. This requirement positively ties the vehicle to that file. The written maintenance record should include date and type of inspection or repair that was performed. Preventive maintenance showed be performed on a regular based on time. mileage, hours operated or other means that may be specified by the manufacturer.

Remarks:

The carrier requested and was given at least 48 hours to produce the following records: financial responsibility, accident register, driver qualification files, hours of service records, and inspection, repair and maintenance records. The carrier only operates vehicles 26,000 gross vehicle weight rating and under.

Supporting documents including bills of lading, dispatch records, routing slips and/or manifests were available for inspection and comparison against certain records. Cesar Bermudez Cano is responsible for the supporting documents. They are maintained by driver, trip or vehicle record. These records could be used to compare against hours of service records. In general, the non-CDL driver short haul exception is used by drivers, when available.

An international sampling method was used to select records for inspection.

Driving record checks were conducted on drivers and all were found to be eligible with no adverse history. Three driver records were reviewed. No drivers had a period of suspension or revocation during the past twelve months.


Commercial motor vehicle inspections were taken off of the MCMIS carrier profile.

There were no acute violations.

Gross revenues were reported from the UTC annual reporting format, a tax return of a good faith estimate of senior management.

Company officials do not have a financial interest in another motor carrier, brokerage or logistics company. The company does operate as an independent contractor for Cardinal Logistics Management Corporation, Concord NC, US DOT 191496 and Exel Inc. Westerville OH, US DOT 482746. Both of these firms are supply chain management companies. Mr. Bermudez has had a working arrangement with these types of companies since 2000.

The carrier has transported very few loads of household goods. The company would use the Better Business Bureau or other non-profit organization as an arbitrator for claims management. Management is in the process of compiling an interstate household goods tariff but currently would form a rate using formats from published intrastate tariffs. There are plans to implement a derivative of Tariff 400N for interstate household goods rates. The firm currently is engaged in retail store delivery in interstate operations.

The compliance review was initiated because this carrier has dual authority.

Carrier officials were not difficult to locate. There has been no recent address change for this company

Using available records and those from agents, the carrier was found to be in general compliance with federal motor carrier safety regulations. Management is conversant in the regulations. Additional educational and technical assistance was given in the areas of driver qualification, hours of service, inspection, repair and maintenance and record retention requirements.

This carrier exited from the new entrant program with a passing safety audit on July 24, 2008.

ENDORSEMENT FOR MOTOR CARRIER POLICIES OF INSURANCE FOR PUBLIC LIABILITY UNDER SECTIONS 29 and 30 OF THE MOTOR CARRIER ACT OF 1980

DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS ENDORSEMENT

ACCIDENT includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

MOTOR VEHICLE means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

BODILY INJURY means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

ENVIRONMENTAL RESTORATION means restitution for the loss, damage, or destruction of natural resources arising out of the accidental discharge, dispersal, release or escape into or upon the land, atmosphere, watercourse, or body of water, of any commodity transported by a motor carrier. This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

PROPERTY DAMAGE means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

PUBLIC LIABILITY means liability for bodily injury, property damage, and environmental restoration.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Interstate Commerce Commission (ICC).

In consideration of the premium stated in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, the insurer (the company) agrees to pay, within the limits of liability described herein, any final judgment recovered against the insured for public liability resulting from negligence in the operation, maintenance or use of motor vehicles subject to the financial responsibility

requirements of Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 regardless of whether or not each motor vehicle is specifically described in the policy and whether or not such negligence occurs on any route or in any territory authorized to be served by the insured or elsewhere. Such insurance as is afforded, for public liability, does not apply to injury to or death of the insured's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, or property transported by the insured, designated as cargo. It is understood and agreed that no condition, provision, stipulation, or limitation contained in the policy, this endorsement, or any other endorsement thereon, or violation thereof, shall relieve the company from liability or from the payment of any final judgment, within the limits of liability herein described, irrespective of the financial condition, insolvency or bankruptcy of the insured. However, all terms, conditions, and limitations in the policy to which the endorsement is attached shall remain in full force and effect as binding between the insured and the company. The insured agrees to reimburse the company for any payment made by the company on account of any accident, claim, or suit involving a breach of the terms of the policy, and for any payment that the company would not have been obligated to make under the provisions of the policy except for the agreement contained in this endorsement.

It is further understood and agreed that, upon failure of the company to pay any final judgment recovered against the insured as provided herein, the judgment creditor may maintain an action in any court of competent jurisdiction against the company to compel such payment.

The limits of the company's liability for the amounts prescribed in this endorsement apply separately to each accident and any payment under the policy because of any one accident shall not operate to reduce the liability of the company for the payment of final judgments resulting from any other accident.


