## TO REGULATED SOLID WASTE COLLECTION COMPANY:

On October 15, 2010, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed with the Code Reviser a Pre-proposal Statement of Inquiry (CR-101) to initiate a rulemaking to consider whether to adopt, by rule, methods for determining the circumstances under which it will permit solid waste, auto transportation and ferry companies to impose a surcharge for fuel costs and the methods of calculating any such fuel surcharge in WAC 480-07, WAC 480-30, WAC 480-51 and WAC 480-70.
