- On July 15, 2011, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Penalty Assessment TV-111065 against Action Moving Services, Inc. (Action Moving) in the amount of \$2,300, alleging 23 violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15 and Tariff 15-C.
- On July 28, 2011, Action Moving filed with the Commission a request for a mitigation hearing. Action Moving did not state a specific amount that it believes is appropriate for a reduced penalty nor did it provide any reason in support of its request.
- On July 29, 2011, Action Moving provided an addendum stating that it has made progress through several audits and trainings conducted by the Commission. Action Moving further states that it intends to show this progress and express the company's goal of compliance at the hearing.
- Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for determining whether the alleged violations of WAC 480-15 and Tariff 15-C occurred and, if so, whether the penalty should be mitigated and, finally, what actions may be necessary for Action Moving to maintain future compliance, pursuant to statutory provisions of RCW 81.04.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 1:30 p.m., on Tuesday, September 6, 2011, in Room 108, First Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.

- The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.
- Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The Commission will provide at its offices in Olympia, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.
- Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission a list enumerating and describing any such documents **no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 31, 2011**, and bring an original and **three (3)** copies to the hearing. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140 and 145.
