Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on July 30, 2013, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Green Mountain H2O LLC in the amount of \$1,800 for violation of WAC 480-110-505, which requires water companies to file an annual report with the Commission by May 1 each year. Green Mountain H2O LLC filed its annual report for 2013 on May 28, 2013, 18 days past the deadline. The Commission sent Green Mountain H2O LLC a Second Notice on January 8, 2014, and a Final Notice on February 12, 2014.

The Commission has not received the \$1,800 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$1,800 balance.
