As required by Washington law (including RCW 80.28.050 and 80.28.060) and the Rules and Regulations issued by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), Pacific Power & Light Company has filed with the Commission an original tariff schedule for electric service in the State of Washington.

Overview

The current system benefits charge (SBC) collection rate is approximately \$10.2 million on an annual basis and was approved in Docket UE-111880 with an effective date of July 1, 2013. As of March 31, 2014, the SBC collection rate represents approximately 3.2 percent of Washington electric revenues.

The Company proposes no change to the SBC collection rate at this time such that annual collections remain at approximately \$10.2 million. Accordingly, the impact on the average monthly residential bill will be zero. The proposal to keep the SBC collection rate unchanged is based on a review of the SBC deferred account balance by the Demand Side Management Advisory Group.
