Host Provided by Party Bus Operator

We at Lucky Limousine highly recommend that an employee of the party bus operator, a host, be on the bus during the full duration of the client's event. Having a host provides; monitoring of the clients / passengers, the amount of alcohol being consumed and safety protection.

The driver has enough responsibility just driving in today's traffic conditions and cannot monitor the passengers at the same time. In most party buses there is a partition between the driver and the passengers not allowing the driver to do and monitoring. This is not Las Vegas, what happens on our busses is being monitored and supervised.

The host does not purchase or serve alcohol for the passengers. They are there to organize food and beverages (we provide bottled water), clean up as needed and again supervise for safety.

Lucky Limousines policy is if the host believes there is danger of any kind they are to inform the driver and have the vehicle stopped. If the danger is not controlled the bus will not move until the individuals out of control have found another means of getting home or they have become controlled. Safety is paramount for all passengers.

There is an additional cost for this host service, however the various risks warrant this addition. We have found that parents, event planners, wineries, breweries and venue managers have been very happy to have this monitoring and control of their arriving guests.

Definition of a "party Bus" is: a bus with Limousine seating, TV monitors for movies, karaoke, and music. Wi-Fi for telephone and

computer connections. Beverage containers for food and alcohol. Glass ware for the beverages. A room on wheels.
