- 1 On May 26, 2015, Annavilla L. Heath d/b/a Movers4U (Movers4U or Applicant) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application for authority to operate as a household goods carrier in the state of Washington under Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 81.80 and Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15.

- 2 On August 18, 2015, the Commission issued a Notice of Intent to Deny Application for Permanent Authority and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing in this matter based on its review and investigation of the application. The Commission alleges that the Applicant did not disclose Larry Heath’s involvement in the ownership of Movers4U, Mr. Heath’s domestic violence conviction in August 2010, and Mr. Heath’s second degree theft conviction in June 2005. The Notice provided Movers4U the opportunity to request a hearing to contest the factual allegations by September 2, 2015.

- 3 On August 21, 2015, Movers4U filed with the Commission a Request for Hearing.

- 4 Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for determining whether Movers4U’s application for permanent authority should be denied due to the concerns raised after Staff’s review and investigation of the application.

- 5 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 1:30 p.m., on Tuesday, September 29, 2015, in Room 206, Second Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.**
