RE: Lincoln County Transfer Station Tipping Fee & Rate Increases - Effective February 1, 2016

Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing this letter to notify you of the annual rate increase to be implemented at the Lincoln County Transfer Station. The rate increase will be adopted by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners as indicated on the attached Exhibit A. Rates will become effective February 1, 2016.

Lincoln County has worked hard to keep rates as low as possible over the past few years. We have accomplished this by keeping annual rate increases in line with the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) imposed by others; foregoing an annual price increase on one occasion, and decreasing recycling bin drop off fees by 10%.

This year we have increased rates by 5% and increased the program fees to \$10 per ton for those cities and collection companies electing to transfer their MSW outside of the County. We have also implemented a rate of \$5.00 (cash discount rate) for household garbage of 2 bags or less to make things easier for those bringing in small quantities.

The 2016 rate increase is necessary due to a reduction in the amount of grant funding we receive to offset a portion of the costs to operate the facility. The alternative would have been a reduction in services at the transfer station or transfer of funds and reduction of service in other departments.


