Dear Cherish Moving LLC:

On February 29, 2016, Cherish Moving LLC filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) to provide residential household goods transportation services in the state of Washington. On March 7, 2016, the Commission approved the application in part and granted Cherish Moving LLC temporary authority to provide those services.

The Commission has determined that Cherish Moving LLC qualifies for permanent household goods carrier authority and approves the application in full. Permit HG067061 issued in the name of Cherish Moving LLC is enclosed, and the company may now operate on a permanent basis.

Cherish Moving LLC must continue to comply with state laws, Commission rules, and the provisions of Tariff 15-C. Failure to do so will result in Commission enforcement action, up to and including revocation of the company's permit.
