Dear Homestead Move and Estate Services LLC:

On May 20, 2016, Homestead Move and Estate Services LLC filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) to provide residential household goods transportation services in the state of Washington. On June 16, 2016, the Commission approved the application in part and granted Homestead Move and Estate Services LLC temporary authority to provide those services.

The Commission has determined that Homestead Move and Estate Services LLC qualifies for permanent household goods carrier authority and approves the application in full. Permit HG067212 issued in the name of Homestead Move and Estate Services LLC is enclosed, and the company may now operate on a permanent basis.

Homestead Move and Estate Services LLC must continue to comply with state laws, Commission rules, and the provisions of Tariff 15-C. Failure to do so will result in Commission enforcement action, up to and including revocation of the company's permit.
