This can happen in a domestic violence, medical emergency, or other call in which the caller may become incapacitated. In these situations with the current services a 911 dispatcher is able to call back, verify or break in to the line when it is busy on call back. Proliferation of wireless services will not replace the benefit to having busy line interrupt and verification on wireline.
