Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) hereby submits proposed revisions, as described below, to its natural gas tariff. This filing, pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC, proposes revisions in the following natural gas tariff sheets.

The primary purpose of this filing is to update the exhibits of the customer authorized curtailment or entitlement customer contact personnel list in Attachments A of PSE’s natural gas interruptible Schedules 85, 86, and 87 and the transportation service Schedules 31T, 41T, 85T, 86T, and 87T. PSE contacts the individuals designated in the lists to notify customers of a curtailment or an overrun/underrun event.

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Besides those changes to Attachments A of PSE's natural gas interruptible and transportation service schedules, this filing also appends the WN U-2 tariff index Sheet No. 4 to include Schedule 149 - Cost Recovery Mechanism for Pipeline Replacement ("CRM").

The tariff sheets described herein reflect an issue date of June 29, 2017, and an effective date of August 1, 2017, which allows PSE and its interruptible and transportation service customers to finalize the lists of authorized curtailment or entitlement personnel prior to the start of 2017-2018 heating season.

Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by WAC 480-90-193, is being accomplished by posting the proposed tariff sheets on the PSE web site immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter. As this filing does not represent an increase in rates or restriction in access to services, notice to the public will be provided under the provisions of WAC 480-90-195(3).
