Completion of Grade Crossing Protective Fund (GCPF) Project

On Feb. 1, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) awarded a GCPF grant totaling \$24,174.77 to Puget Sound & Pacific Railroad (PSAP) for a project related to upgrading warning devices at the Tyler St. crossing in Aberdeen, identified as USDOT 096029N. The actual cost of the project was \$22,113.13.

On Jun. 7, 2019, PSAP submitted a request for reimbursement. Rail Safety staff inspected the crossing on May 13, 2019, and confirmed that the upgrades were completed according to the specifications outlined in the order approving the grant.
