RE: Commission Staff's Letter Confirming Compliance

DG-180072 - Thomco Construction, Inc. - Investigation #7628

Dear Mr. Johnson:

Commission staff has reviewed the compliance order for Thomco Construction, Inc. (Company), dated January 24, 2018. Compliance with the order required the following items be met:

- \$1,000 penalty for one violation of RCW 19.122.030(2); and
- The opportunity to suspend the \$1,000 penalty if Company employees complete National Utility Contractor Association (NUCA) Dig Safe Training within 12 months of the issuance of a penalty assessment by the Commission, and the Company incurs no additional violations of RCW 19.122 within 12 months of the penalty assessment.

On January 29, 2018, the Company notified the Commission that it accepted the conditions to suspend the \$1,000 penalty amount and attend NUCA Dig Safe Training within 12 months. On October 22, 2018, the Company notified the Commission that it submitted payment of the \$1,000 penalty in lieu of attending NUCA Dig Safe Training. The Commission received payment in full of the \$1,000 penalty on October 24, 2018.

Staff believes that the Company has fully complied with the Commission's order, and recommend this docket be closed.
