Status of Compliance of Companies Named in Notice of Intent to Cancel Certificate

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On October 19, 2018, the Commission served a Notice of Intent to Cancel Solid Waste Collection Certificate and Opportunity to Request a Hearing (Notice) on one or more solid waste collection companies. The Notice stated that the Commission would revoke each company's registration unless, within 30 days, the company (1) came into compliance with applicable law by submitting the delinquent annual report and paying the required regulatory fee or (2) requested a hearing to demonstrate why the company's registration should not be revoked.

More than thirty days have now elapsed since the last company was served with the Notice. As of December 13, 2018, all three companies have come into compliance. Because these companies are now in compliance, the Commission need not revoke their registrations.
