RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Bodine Construction in the Amount of \$2,000, Docket DG-190370

TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 18, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$2,000 penalty (Penalty Assessment) against Bodine Construction (Bodine or Company) for two violations of Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 19.122. In the Penalty Assessment, the Commission offered the Company the option to suspend, and ultimately waive, a \$1,500 portion of the penalty subject to the conditions that (1) Company employees, including management and crew foremen, attend Dig Safe training provided through the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the date of the Penalty Assessment; and (2) the Company commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within 12 months from the date of the Penalty Assessment.

On July 1, 2019, the Company paid the \$500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and notified the Commission that it accepted the remaining conditions, and on October 10, 2019, the Company submitted a certificate of completion for NUCA Dig Safe training.

On June 25, 2020, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter recommending the Commission waive the \$1,500 suspended portion of the penalty and close the docket. Staff believes that Bodine has met all of the conditions.

The Commission agrees that Bodine has complied with the conditions of the penalty suspension. The \$1,500 suspended penalty is thus waived, and this docket is closed.
