Dear Mr. Johnson:

On October 2, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$5,700 penalty in Docket TE-190790 against Lemyn's Legacy Inc., d/b/a Spokane Party Bus (Spokane Party Bus or Company) for violations of WAC 480-30-221, Vehicle and Driver Safety Requirements, which adopts Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations (49 CFR) Part 391 – Qualifications of Drivers, 49 CFR Part 393 – Parts and Accessories Necessary for Safe Operation, and 49 CFR Part 395 – Hours of Service of Drivers.

On October 28, 2019, the Commission issued an order granting mitigation to \$3,000. In addition, the Commission suspended a \$2,500 portion of the penalty for a period of two years before being waived, subject to the conditions that: (1) Spokane Party Bus must pay the \$500 portion of the penalty that is not suspended within 10 days of the order, (2) the Company may not incur any repeat violations of critical regulations, and (3) Spokane Party Bus must register with the Uniform Carrier Registration program and pay applicable fees.

On November 5, 2019, staff and the Company came to a mutual agreement on a proposed payment plan, as follows:

Spokane Party Bus is aware that if it fails to pay any installment by the due date, the entire remaining balance, including the suspended penalty, will become immediately due and payable without further Commission order.
