Dear Mr. Pittman:

As you are aware, on January 22, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Andrew Pittman in the amount of \$1,000 for violations of RCW 19.122.030(2), failing to request a dig ticket prior to excavating. The payment was due by February 6, 2020.

The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated March 11, 2020, indicating that the balance of \$1,000 was due. To date, the Commission has not received payment of the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission may forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. In that event, you likely would incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest, which would be added to your outstanding \$1,000 balance.
