TO OUR VALUED RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS:

Stanley's Sanitary Service has filed a proposal with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission increasing our rates to recover increased cost. The disposal rate at Cowlitz County Landfill has increased by \$18.51 per ton since we last increased our rates in 2013. The replacement of worn out collection equipment and our insurance renewal included a 27% cost increase. We are requesting those rates, if approved, to be effective August 1, 2020.



Stanley's Sanitary Service has filed a proposal with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission increasing our rates to recover increased operating expenses. The disposal rate at Cowlitz County Landfill has increased by \$18.51 per ton since we last increased our rates in 2013. The replacement of worn out collection equipment and our insurance renewal included a 27% cost increase. We are requesting those rates, if approved, to be effective August 1, 2020.
