TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On June 22, 2020, PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company, (Pacific Power or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a Petition for Declaratory Order (Petition) in Docket UE-200573. Pacific Power requests that the Commission approve its Avoided Cost Methodology (ACM) for the Company's power purchases from large qualified facilities of greater than five megawatts, as described in Exhibit A to the Company's Petition.

WAC 480-106-050(5) provides that "Each utility shall file and obtain commission approval of its Avoided cost rate methodology for qualifying facilities with capacity greater than five megawatts."

The Petition seeks Commission approval of Pacific Power's proposed ACM through a declaratory order.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That any interested persons may respond to the Petition by filing a written response with the Commission no later than Monday, July 13, 2020, at 5 p.m.
