TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 2, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$1,000 penalty (Penalty Assessment) against Lynx Landsite Development (Lynx or Company) for one violation of Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 19.122. In the Penalty Assessment, the Commission offered the Company the option to suspend and ultimately waive the penalty subject to the conditions that (1) Lynx management and field crew responsible for excavation attend Dig Safe training provided through the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the date of the Penalty Assessment and (2) the Company commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within 12 months from the date of the Penalty Assessment.

On September 16, 2020, the Company notified the Commission that it accepted the conditions.

On October 22, 2021, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that the Company had submitted a certificate of completion for NUCA Dig Safe training and that the Company had not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the Penalty Assessment. In its letter, Staff recommends the Commission waive the \$1,000 suspended penalty and close the docket.

The Commission agrees that Lynx has complied with the conditions of the Penalty Assessment. The \$1,000 suspended penalty is thus waived, and this docket is closed.
