Dear Ms. Maxwell:

Commission staff (staff) has reviewed the compliance order for Zayo (or Company) dated October 5, 2020. Compliance with the order required the following items be met:

- \$1,000 penalty for one violation of RCW 19.122, with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive, \$800 of the penalty amount if the Company incurs no other dig law violations within 12 months.

On October 14, 2020, Zayo notified the Commission of its acceptance of the conditions and made a payment of \$200. The Company has not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the penalty assessment.

Staff believes Zayo has fully complied with the Commission's order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$800 penalty amount and close the docket.
