SUBJECT: Rate increase Notice from Lambs Disposal

Dear Customer:

January 24, 2022

Lamb's Disposal has filed a request for a rate increase with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC). We have never filed for a rate increase since we have been in business (10 years) March of 2011 to present. In that time, the Company has experienced higher costs in dumping fee's, (from \$61.00 to \$75.00 a ton), employee wages, fuel, and truck equipment and other company equipment and supplies.

If approved by the WUTC, the proposed rates below will become effective March 1, 2022.
