**Re: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Dockets TV-220149/220150 (Consolidated)**

Dear Mr. Lu:

As you are aware, on April 4, 2022, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Grandma's Boy Moving Co. in the amount of \$8,900 for violations of the Commission's laws and rules. On April 11, 2022, the Commission entered Order 01 imposing and suspending penalties. On March 31, 2023, Commission Staff filed a letter in these dockets stating that Grandma's Boy Moving Co. failed to comply with the terms of Order 01, and requesting that the Commission impose the suspended portion of the penalty. On April 12, 2023, a Final Notice was sent to Grandma's Boy Moving Co. in the amount of \$2,700, which was due on receipt. To date, the Commission has not received the balance due.

**This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection.** You will likely incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees and interest, which will be added to the outstanding \$2,700 balance.
