Stanley's Sanitary Service has filed a proposal with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission increasing our rates to recover significantly increased operating costs incurred since we last increased our rates in 2020. Many of the increased costs are due to inflation but fuel cost, labor costs and operating equipment costs represent the more significant changes.

We are requesting those rates, if approved, to be effective July 1, 2023.
