Dear Mr. Killip:

On August 2, 2023, Bob's Septic was issued a \$1,000 penalty for a violation of RCW 19.122.030(2). Bob's Septic was provided the opportunity to suspend an \$800 portion of the penalty amount and ultimately waived on the following conditions:

- Bob's Septic employees attend Dig Safe training provided through the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the date of the penalty assessment; and
- Submit documentation of attendance of Dig Safe training to the Commission; and
- Commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within the 12 months following the penalty assessment.

On August 15, 2023, the Commission received a payment of \$200. On October 11, 2023, the Commission received verification of completion of Dig Safe training. Bob's Septic has had no further violations of RCW 19.122.
