TO ALL PARTIES:

King County has requested continuance of the prehearing conference scheduled for May 9, and a delay of the deadline for prefiling its testimony and exhibits. King County has requested a continuance on the basis that its expert witness is out of town for two weeks. After consultation with other parties, King County proposes a date of May 31.

The Commission's May calendar is extremely congested. The Commissioners are not available May 31, and few other May dates are available.

It does not appear that King County's expert witness is necessary to the prehearing conference. It is important that this complaint be heard in a timely manner. The Commission therefore denies the request to change the date of prehearing conference.

The Commission will grant a one-week delay in the deadline for prefiling King County's testimony and exhibits, to allow King County additional time for preparation of its case. King County's prefiled testimony and exhibits must be filed on or before May 16, 1994.

The prehearing conference will be held as scheduled on May 9 at 1:30 p.m.
