## TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 13, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$1,000 penalty (Penalty Assessment) TTAP Construction Services LLC (TTAP or Company) for one violation of Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 19.122.055(1)(a). In the Penalty Assessment, the Commission offered the Company the option to suspend and ultimately waive an \$800 portion of the penalty subject to the conditions that: a) the Company timely pay the \$200 portion of the penalty that was not suspended, b) TTAP supervisors and field crew responsible for excavation attend National Utility Contractors Association Dig Safe online training, and c) the Company commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within 12 months from the date of the Penalty Assessment.

On September 21, 2021, the Company notified the Commission that it accepted the conditions and paid the \$200 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On October 13, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that the Company had verified completion of the required training and had not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the Penalty Assessment. In its letter, Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended penalty and close the docket.

The Commission agrees that TTAP has complied with the conditions of the Penalty Assessment. The penalty is thus waived, and this docket is closed.
