RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment TV-230215

Dear Mr. Tuttle:

As you are aware, on April 11, 2023, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Alto Moving in the amount of \$4,700 for violations of the Commission's rules and laws. On April 27, 2023, Alto Moving requested mitigation of the penalties. On June 29, 2023, the Commission entered Order 01, Denying Mitigation, and Suspending the Penalty in Part. The Commission suspended a \$3,500 portion of the penalty for a period of two years, subject to condition. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated August 21, 2023, indicating that the balance of \$1,200 was due. To date, the Commission has not received payment of the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission may forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. In that event, you will likely incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest, which would be added to your outstanding \$1,200 balance.
