1 Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Staff) and Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink) intend to file a multiparty settlement agreement today. The Public Counsel Unit of the Washington State Office of the Attorney General (Public Counsel) has intervened in this docket but will not be joining the agreement.

2 Anticipating the altered procedural posture that will be caused by the Staff-Company settlement, Staff, CenturyLink, and Public Counsel conferred by telephone and now jointly move under WAC 480-07-385 for the following modifications to the procedural schedule approved by the Commission in its Notice Revising Procedural Schedule (August 6, 2015):



The hearing dates remain the same as in the August 6 revision, with the proposed change in focus from an evidentiary hearing to a settlement hearing.
