Attached are Puget Sound Energy's ("PSE's") replacement pages of its 2019 Annual Conservation Report and 2018-2019 Biennial Conservation Report in the above-referenced docket. Revised documents included in this filing are: the 2019 Annual Conservation Report and 2018-2019 Biennial Summary; Exhibit 1: 2019 Savings and Expenses; Exhibit 2: 2019 Program Cost Effectiveness; Appendix 2, Exhibit 2: 2018-2019 Program Cost Effectiveness; and Appendix 3: The Washington Department of Commerce 2018-2019 EIA report.

The 2019 Annual Conservation Report and 2018-2019 Biennial Summary and associated Exhibits and Appendices filed June 1, 2020 contain an electric savings error of 2,371 Megawatt-Hours ("MWh") in the Retail Lighting program, where the indicated amount was overstated in the original Report. This error affected the Residential Sector, Portfolio, and biennial savings results. PSE believes that it is prudent to make the downward savings revision, reflected in this replacement filing, prior to the Commission's discussion of its 2018-2019 electric savings during the September 10, 2020 Open Meeting.

The savings error was attributed to an invoice error from a third-party vendor in July of 2019 in the Retail Lighting program. To correct the error, PSE is reducing electric savings by 2,371 MWh. The over-payment of \$192,000 will be credited to PSE in the fall of 2020.

Below is a table that shows the 2,371 MWh reduction of savings and the resultant effect on key annual and biennial savings, excess savings, and cost-effectiveness.
