**NOTICE REVISING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

RE: *In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of Glacier Recycle, LLC; Hungry Buzzard Recovery, LLC; and T&T Recovery, Inc.*, Docket TG-072226

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 28, 2008, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 02 – *Prehearing Conference Order* in this matter. Order 02 set out the procedural schedule for this docket, including a hearing on the merits to be held on September 9-11, 2008.

On August 5, 2008, Commission Staff requested to revise all remaining dates on the procedural schedule in this matter by way of a two month continuance of each of those remaining deadlines and dates. Staff requested this continuance to allow further exploration of potential settlement of this matter. Staff’s request stated that all parties had been consulted and were in agreement with the request.

Staff’s request to extend the remaining dates on the procedural schedule is granted. The request complies with the requirements in WAC 480-07-385 for such requests, and will not prejudice the parties or the Commission. The Commission revises the procedural schedule as follows:
