Pursuant to paragraph 246 of Final Order No. 6, Dockets UE-040641 and UG-040640 et al.<sup>1</sup>, for the purpose of the Qualifying Storm Loss Deferral Mechanism, Puget Sound Energy ("PSE") hereby provides a detailed report for the qualifying event which started on October 13, 2020.

This sixth 2020 Qualifying Event Report, as of December 31, 2020, summarizes the preliminary electric system restoration costs associated with the January 13<sup>th</sup>, January 31<sup>st</sup>, February 7<sup>th</sup>, February 23<sup>rd</sup>, September 7<sup>th</sup>, and October 13<sup>th</sup> events. Costs for these events will continue to be included in upcoming storm reporting.
