Please provide all presentations and memos related to the decision to install selective catalytic reduction (SCR) technology at Jim Bridger units 3 and 4, including but not limited to any documents (including emails) that compare or contrast SCR to natural gas conversion and any documents that were presented to the executive board or committee that gave the final authorization for SCR installation.

Response to WUTC Data Request 90

PacifiCorp objects to this request as overly broad, unduly burdensome, not reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence, and as requesting information protected by the attorney-client privilege or attorney work product doctrine. Without waiving these objections, the Company responds as follows:

Although there is no executive board or committee authorization that occurs under PacifiCorp's governance policies, please refer to Confidential Attachment WUTC 90 -1 and Confidential Attachment WUTC 90 -2, which provide project proposals for Jim Bridger Unit 3 and Jim Bridger Unit 4, respectively. The project proposals are the basis of the Company's appropriation request (APR) project approval process. The economic analyses underlying the Company's approval process, as provided in the APRs, are consistent with the Company's Wyoming Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN), Utah Voluntary Procurement Pre-approval, and 2013 Integrated Resource Plan filings made before the APR approval process. Note: APR 10003396 is for Jim Bridger Unit 3, and APR 10009398 is for Jim Bridger Unit 4.
