1 MS. SACILOTTO: Jean, can you --2 ALJ ARLOW: I guess the question is whether or 3 not a simple software modification to the application 4 program might do the job? 5 MR. WILSON: Or, Your Honor, I know that Qwest 6 has report generating capabilities out of LFACS to get 7 the information as you correctly asked. They have 8 mechanisms to determine spare facilities. This may be 9 the LAIS and LEAD systems that actually generate the 10 reports out of LFACS. I think either Ms. Liston doesn't 11 know this or there's some question we haven't asked 12 here. 13 MS. KILGORE: And I would just like to point 14 to Qwest Exhibit 425, which is attached to Ms. Liston's 15 direct testimony, dated June 5 of 2001.
