- On September 15, 2005, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Penalty Assessment No. TV-050537 against All My Sons Moving & Storage of Seattle, Inc. (All My Sons) in the amount of \$69,600.00, alleging 696 violations of Commission rules and household goods tariff, specifically, WAC 480-015 and Commission Tariff 15-A.
- On September 28, 2005, All My Sons filed with the Commission a Request For Hearing, or in the alternative a request for mitigation of the amount of the penalties.
- The Commission will hear this matter pursuant to Part IV of chapter 34.05 RCW pertaining to adjudicative proceedings, including but not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.431, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW 34.05.452. Statutes involved, in addition to those previously cited, include those within chapters 81.01 RCW, 81.04 RCW and RCW 81.80 RCW, including but not limited to RCW 80.01.040, RCW 81.04.380, RCW 81.80.130, RCW 81.80.280, RCW 81.80.290, and RCW 81.80.330, and under chapter 480-07 WAC and chapter 480-15 WAC, including but not limited to WAC 480-07-145, WAC 480-07-150, WAC 480-07-440, WAC 480-07-450, WAC 480-07-470, WAC 480-07-490, WAC 480-07-490,

The ultimate issues include whether the penalty should be mitigated as requested, and what actions are necessary for All My Sons, to cure previous instances of non-compliance with state law and Commission rules and to maintain substantial future compliance, pursuant to statutory provisions of chapter 81.04 RCW.

- Although the Commission declines to conduct this proceeding as a brief adjudicative proceeding under WAC 480-07-610, the Commission intends that the adjudication proceed efficiently and with the greatest degree of informality consistent with fairness and the nature of the proceeding. *See RCW 34.12.010*
